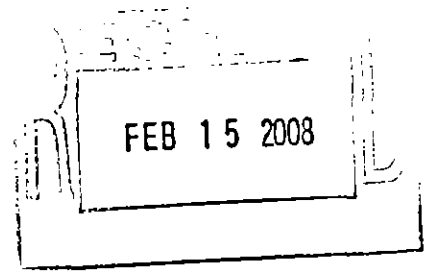

Dear Mayor and Council members:




