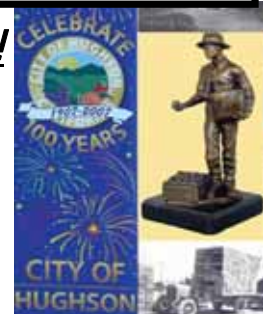

Going Away?


These common sense rules will help you and your family have a safe and happy vacation.
An empty house is a tempting target for a burglary. Use this checklist of tips to safeguard your home while you are gone.



- Have quality locks on all doors & windows, and use them!
- Engrave your valuables with your drivers license # (preceded by "CA") and post "Operation Identification" stickers on entry doors and windows. (available from Crime Preventions/S.T.A.R.S Office)
- Never leave your house key hidden outside under a doormat, in a flower pot or on the ledge of a door. Burglars know these places too!
- Stop all deliveries or arrange for someone to pick up your mail, newspapers and packages.
- Arrange for someone to mow your lawn and rake your leaves to give your home a lived-in look.
- Use timers to turn lights and a radio on /off at appropriate times. Hide garbage cans in the garage or a storage shed. Empty garbage cans tell a burglar you are away, especially when everyone else's are full.
- Close and lock garage doors and windows. Ask a neighbor to watch the house while you are away.
- Leave your vacation address and telephone number with a neighbor so you can be reached in an emergency.

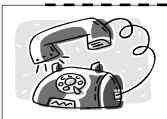
