"Get to know your HOUSE"


Do you know how to
shut off your Utilities in an
Emergency?



It's a good idea for all
responsible household members to be familiar with
where your shut-off valve's are located in your
home.

Water: Every home has a shut-off valve up the
by house. It can look like either one of these.
(older homes may not).

Turn clockwise until firm. Check to see
if water has stopped
running (your front
hose tap is the best
way to check).



There is also a valve in the back
of the toilet that can be turned off if our
toilet is going to overflow.



Electricity: Always shut off all the individual
circuits **before** shutting off the main circuit
breaker.

Gas: Only turn gas off if:

- You smell or hear it leaking.
- You see structural damage to your house.
- There's a fire in close proximity to your home.
- You are told to do so by authorities.



To shut off the gas, take these precautions:

- If it is dark, use only battery-powered flashlights or lanterns to help you find the meter.
- Know where a wrench is stored so it will be available.
- The shut-off valve is located next to the meter on the inlet pipe.
- Use a crescent wrench or an Emergency Gas Shut-Off Wrench and turn the valve a quarter turn in either direction so that it runs perpendicular (crosswise) to the pipe.

Remember—once the gas is turned off, it can only be turned back on by a professional. In an emergency, that could take a week or more.

Do not use matches, lighters, or open flame appliances; operate electrical switches anywhere in your home, or start a car in your garage or driveway until you are sure no gas leaks exist.

Don't forget to pay your Utility Bill by the last business day of the month to avoid a 10% penalty.
