 To avoid a violation please follow this schedule:  
**MON—WATERING PROHIBITED**

**Tues/Thurs/Sat—EVEN**  
**Wed/Fri/Sun—ODD**  
 .....  
**NO WATERING ANY DAY NOON-7PM**




Don't forget to pay your Utility Bill by the last business day of the month to avoid a 10% penalty.

**KEEP YOUR DOG ON A LEASH.....**  
**IT'S THE LAW!**  
 Hughson Municipal Code 6.16.020 says  
 No animal, except a domestic cat, shall be allowed to be off a leash unless on the owners property.  
 2. You are not to enter private property without the consent of the owner. **(This includes their lawn!!!)**  
 3. Habitually make loud noises  
 4. Act in such other manner so as to constitute a public nuisance.  
**Be courteous and pick up after your dog, dispose of the waste properly and remember It's the law if it's not on YOUR property!!!**
