- Story Time at Hughson Library.....Thursday mornings at 11:30  
Preschool story time is new & classic picture books, flannel board and puppet stories, finger plays, music and dancing , all for preschoolers aged 3-5 and their caregivers. (30 minutes)
- Snuggles Project.....February 1—April 29th  
Help make Snuggles, small security blankets for shelter animals. These blankets will help bring security and warmth to animals at the Thomas W. Mayfield Regional Animal Services Center.
