KEEP YOUR DOG ON A LEASH... IT'S THE LAW ...

Hughson Municipal Code 6.16.020 says



1. No animal, except a domestic cat, shall be allowed to be off a leash unless on the owners property.
2. You are not to enter private property without the consent of the owner. **(This includes their lawn!!!)**
3. Not to habitually make loud noises.
4. Not to act in such other manner so as to constitute a public nuisance.

Be courteous and pick up after your dog, dispose of the waste properly and remember It's the law if it's not on YOUR property!!!



Don't forget to pay your Utility Bill by the last business day of the month to avoid a 10% penalty.
