Did you know that the 2013/2014 rainfall season has been the driest one on record for the State of California? That lack of water means more dry grass and fire hazards. Please do your part to keep our city and our homes safe. Clean your part of the alley and remove weeds, dry grass, old furniture or garbage that could fuel a fire.

WATER CONSERVATION TIPS:

1. Water in 5 minute cycles.
2. Turn off the water while brushing your teeth.
3. Wash only full loads in your washing machine.
4. Take shorter showers
5. When washing dishes by hand, don't leave the water running.
6. Don't run the hose while washing your car.
7. Put a layer of mulch around trees and plants.
8. Check for leaking pipes and faucets
9. Check for toilet leaks
10. Install low-flow shower heads.



Don't forget to pay your Utility Bill by the last business day of the month to avoid a 10% penalty.
