NEWS:

City Staff will be "flushing" hydrants in the upcoming weeks. This is done to remove sediment from the water pipes to maintain water clarity and quality in the water distribution system. Although it may appear that water is being wasted, this process is part of a routine maintenance program necessary to maintain the integrity of the water system allowing the City to continue to deliver the highest quality water possible to our customers.

The City's water distribution system is a complex network of pipes and storage and storage reservoirs where sediment or deposits may naturally accumulate over time. If not removed, these materials may cause water quality deterioration, taste and odor problems or discoloration of water. Water may also stagnate in lesser used parts of the distribution system also resulting in degraded water quality.

Pilot Water Use Audit

The City will offer a pilot water use audit to residents who are interested in conserving water and saving money. For those who volunteer, Public Works and City Hall staff will review water usage to determine how much water is being used, including any leaks that may be occurring, as well as tips on how to conserve.
