Construction on **Tully Road**, which will repave the roadway and include new utility infrastructure—is underway and is expected to be completed in mid October 2015. During this time, Tully Road at Santa Fe will be closed to traffic. However, the homes and businesses on Tully Road will have full access via Whitmore Avenue during construction. Construction started on **Hughson Avenue** east of 7th Street (adjacent to Hughson High School) on Monday, August 3, 2015 and is expected to be completed in 2 to 3 weeks last weeks. The project will improve the condition of the pavement, which is very uneven, and will add sidewalks on the north side. Thank you for your patience and cooperation. NEWS:

City Staff will be "flushing" hydrants in the upcoming weeks. This is done to remove sediment from the water pipes to maintain water clarity and quality in the water distribution system. Although it may appear that water is being wasted, this process is part of a routine maintenance program necessary to maintain the integrity of the water system allowing the City to continue to deliver the highest quality water possible to our customers.

The City's water distribution system is a complex network of pipes and storage and storage reservoirs where sediment or deposits may naturally accumulate overtime. If not removed, these materials may cause water quality deterioration, taste and odor problems or discoloration of water. Water may also stagnate in lesser used parts of the distribution system also resulting in degraded water quality.

New Rates Adopted by City Council on July 13, 2015 Following Proposition 218 Notification Process

Residential customers will see the increase from \$25.75 to \$27.22 take effective in August for the fixed rate. The metered rate will increase from \$1.48 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.57 per 1,000 gallons in September. The increase will allow the City to access funding for critical water system improvements to address State mandated water quality issues.

Now that Summer is right around the corner here are some **WATER CONSERVATION TIPS:**

1. Water in 5 minute cycles.
2. Turn off the water while brushing your teeth.
3. Wash only full loads in your washing machine.
4. Take shorter showers

6. Don't run the hose while washing your car.
7. Put a layer of mulch around trees and plants.
8. Check for leaking pipes and faucets
9. Check for toilet leaks
10. Install low-flow shower heads.
