

BLUE BAG RECYCLING IS HERE!

Blue Bag Pilot Program-MARCH 2016-JULY 2016 (4 MONTHS)

Things have changed in Hughson with recycling, but you can still continue to recycle. The City of Hughson is giving Blue Bags (30-40 gallons) for recyclables to Hughson residents that sign up for the program at City Hall (7018 Pine Street, Hughson, CA). Helps us meet State requirements to cut our waste stream in half! Your help will make it happen! Just fill the bags with your recyclables and put them in your black garbage can. It's that easy! All types of recyclables can go into the same bag. The recyclables will be pulled out and processed at our resource recovery facilities. See the photos below for what can be recycled.

WHAT GOES IN THE BLUE BAG FOR RECYCLING?



TIN, STEEL & ALUMINUM CANS:

- Labels are okay. Crushing cans save space.
- Aluminum cans, aluminum foil trays and pie plates, and foil products.
- Empty and lightly rinse.



PLASTIC BOTTLES & JARS

- Soda, water, milk jugs, soap bottles and plastic bottles with a "neck".
- Plastics 1 through 7.
- Remove any bottle caps which are not recyclable.
- Crush or flatten to save space.
- Empty and lightly rinse.



GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

- Leave the lid off and put it into the blue bag.
- Empty and lightly rinse.
- Do not break the bottles and jars.

NEWSPAPERS, BROWN BAGS, CARDBOARD, OTHER CLEAN PAPER, & FOODWASTE:

- Newspapers, brown paper bags, telephone books, magazines, mixed paper, junk mail, computer paper and cardboard.
- Remove cardboard box liners
- Flatten cardboard boxes
