City of Hughson Issues Request for Proposals for Reuse Options and Lease for City Owned Property on Leedom Road along the Tuolumne River

“The City of Hughson is soliciting proposals from interested parties willing to lease City owned land for viable and creative reuse (agriculture, education, recreation, solar, etc.).”

Based on the approval by the City Council, the City of Hughson issued a Request for Proposals for Reuse Options and Lease for City Owned Property on Leedom Road along the Tuolumne River. The purpose of the lease agreement is to maximize the revenue to the City for the approximate 35-acre property currently consisting mostly of undeveloped lands that previously contained the ponds for the City’s former waste water treatment facility. The City will consider both short term (3 or 5 year) and long term (10 or 25 year) lease proposals. The City will also consider both fixed and variable lease rates depending on the reuse.
