

Code Enforcement Tip of the Month

This is a new section of the City Newsletter which is intended to provide information to residents on various City codes or issues which affect quality of life, neighborhood safety, cleanliness and blight. It further allows the City to engage in positive dialogue with the residents about these important issues. Each month, the City will share a Tip aimed to either help improve the aesthetic quality of homes, streets and neighborhoods or improve unsafe conditions.

November Tip of The Month: Abandoned Vehicles and Parts

Please note, the accumulation and storage of abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles or parts creates a condition which can reduce property values, creates blight and neighborhood deterioration, invites theft and vandalism, creates fire hazards, constitutes an attractive nuisance creating a hazard for children, creates a safe harbor for rodents and insects and is generally unsightly.

All such vehicles must be placed out of sight in a garage, backyard or offsite. The City of Hughson offers Abandoned Vehicle Abatement through Code Enforcement. For more information or to report a vehicle(s) call (209) 883-4052, Ext.39.

There are program and services available to assist with these vehicles:

- **Charitable Organizations** often accept vehicle donations and offer a tax deduction.
