
BACKGROUND / HISTORY

1972	Hughson Becomes a City
1970's - 1990's	City Constructs Water Wells No. 3 – 7
2006	State Reduces Arsenic MCL from 50 ppb to 10 ppb
2012	State Issues Compliance Orders - Arsenic & Nitrates
2013 - 2017	City Designs & Engineers Well Project to Comply
2015	City Adopts Rate Increase to Fund New Well Project
2017	Funding Agreement with State for New Well Project
2019	Expected Completion of New Well Project

DEBT SUMMARY & CITY NEEDS

Debt Summary: \$361 K in Annual Payments

- \$77 K annually for 1997 System Improvement Project
- \$173 K annually for Fox Road Water Tank
- \$110 K annually for New Well Project
- Loans to be paid off in 2021, 2026 and 2050 respectively
