City Manager Mendez updated the Council on the Stanislaus County Equal Rights Ceremony, an upcoming event he will be attending on October 5, 2018. He reminded the Council of the upcoming "Concert Series in the Park" event being held on October 6, 2018. He reported to the City Council that in the month of October, the City will be partnering with Hughson Fire Protection District and Hughson Police Services to host Hughson Elementary 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classes at each location to continue the annual discussion with Hughson's future generations. He informed the City Council about the new flag collection receptacle, provided by the Hughson American Legion Post 872 and Hughson Fire Protection District, located in front of the Hughson Fire Station.

Deputy City Clerk Gose reported to the Council that the newly adopted "City of Hughson Vision Statement" plaque is now being displayed in the Council Chambers.

Director Esenwein provided the Council with an update regarding the two vacant positions (Community Development Director and Customer Service Clerk) within the City.

**Police Services:**

Chief Seymour provided the City Council with the latest Crime Statistic Report.

**Student Representative:**

Student Representative Kerr reminded the City Council that the week of September 24-28, 2018 was Homecoming Week. He informed the Council that on October 24, 2018, Hughson High School Ag Students would be attending the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis. He updated the Council on the proposed future Life of a Husky events, and a Freshman Conference for upcoming freshman students.

He provided a reminder of the Hughson United Soccer League pancake breakfast scheduled for October 14, 2018, and a reminder of the Hughson Tent, Trunk or Treat located at Lebright Park, scheduled for October 31, 2018.
