Announcement of Lea Simvoulakis as Incoming Hughson Community Development Director



Ms. Simvoulakis will begin with the City of Hughson on January 2, 2019 and join the City's management team. She will lead and oversee key functional areas of the City including planning, building, code enforcement, public works, utilities, and parks and recreation. She will also work closely with the Mayor, City Council and City Attorney as needed on a variety of City projects and initiatives. Ms. Simvoulakis has worked with the City of San José since 2014 and has very strong technical skills in the areas of land use and planning. Prior to then, she held several positions, while completing her education in the Southern California area, with local municipalities and legal firms. She holds a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and History from the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), Dual Master's Degrees in Urban Planning and Public Administration from the University of Southern California (USC), and a Juris Doctorate in Law from Southwestern Law School. Ms. Simvoulakis is married to her husband Jon Sonnenberg and they have one child named Michael who is 15 months old.

Christmas Tree Collection

Gilton will be doing curbside collection during the first two full weeks in January (7th through 18th). Trees will need to be in front of the house, placed on the street next to the curb, and away from can. Trees will be collected on normal collection day and need to have all stands, lights and ornaments removed.



Well 7 Replacement Project Phase I to Begin – Update



On October 8, 2018, the Hughson City Council awarded the Well No. 7 Replacement Project Phase I to Anthony J. Prieto Water Well Drilling in the amount of \$891,319. This initial phase will consist of well drilling and the upgrade to the existing sewer lift station on Whitmore Avenue and Tully Road. This is a portion of the larger City municipal water infrastructure project that includes the construction two new water well sites, an arsenic water treatment system, a 1.0-million-gallon concrete storage/blending tank and new water distribution pipeline to connect the well sites. Hughson Well No. 9 will be situated just east of Grossi Fabrication and Hughson Well No. 10 will be situated just south of California TrusFrame. The sewer pump improvements are underway and the well construction is scheduled to commence on January 7, 2019, and weather permitting, should be complete by the end of March 2019. The next phase of the project will be initiated in the spring of 2019 and the entire project is expected to take 18 months to complete.
