Well 7 Replacement Project – Update



The sewer pump improvements were completed during the month of January. The well construction began in March 2019 with underground work and was completed in April. The well drilling work (that will take 2-3 weeks to complete) is anticipated to commence this month at the site by Grossi Fabrication and continue to the site by California TrusFrame.

Santa Fe Overlay Phase I

On March 11, 2019, the Hughson City Council awarded the Santa Fe Overlay Project Phase I to T&S Intermodal. Construction began on April 8, 2019 and construction has been completed. The notice of completion will be taken to Council on May 13, 2019 for approval. This initial phase of the project covers 1.2 miles, between Hatch Rd. and Whitmore Ave., and widened the major roadway and applied an overlay of asphalt concrete.




