On June 24, 2019, Council Member Mark Fontana announced that he and his wife were in the process of purchasing property outside of the City of Hughson and if all went as planned, they would be moving and he would need to step down from his elected position on the Hughson City Council. At the July 22, 2019 Hughson City Council meeting, Council Member Fontana's written resignation was accepted by the City Council who also presented Council Member Fontana with a plaque thanking him for his many years of service to the City of Hughson.

The City Council then directed staff to invite applications for the vacant Council seat and determined that an appointment would be made on September 9, 2019. In order to be eligible for consideration, the candidate is required to be a registered voter residing in the City Limits of Hughson.
