The City of Hughson’s recruitment process for the Public Works Superintendent position attracted applications from thirteen professionals from the region. Ten of the thirteen applicants were interviewed and ranked by an expert panel. Jose was one of four finalists invited back to the selection interview with the Community Development Director and the City Manager. The City of Hughson Public Works Superintendent position was offered to and accepted by Jose.

Jose has worked for the City of Hughson since July of 2015, having stints in both the areas of public works and utilities. Jose is a Hughson alumnus, and is passionate about the welfare of the Hughson community. Prior to working for the City, Jose worked for Hughson Farm Supply for ten years. Jose will begin his role as the Public Works Superintendent as of today, October 16, 2019.
