## **Hughson Prepares for the Holiday Season** *Halloween and Thanksgiving Events First Up*

On October 31, 2019, the City of Hughson and its local partners, will kick off the winter holiday season at Lebright Fields (corner of Fox Road and Charles Avenue) with the **7th Annual Halloween Trunk or Tent and Treat** event (5pm - 8pm). Local organizations will decorate trunks and tents at the park and pass out candy and other treats to children of all ages. Local DJ Juan Carlos Lupercio will set the tone with music for the occasion. City Officials (City Hall, Police and Fire) will bring around the popular City Caravan with lights and sirens and, in addition to Lebright Fields, make stops at local churches hosting harvest gatherings (Hughson Latter-Day Saints/1930 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Hughson Full Gospel Assembly of God/2007 5<sup>th</sup> Street).
