Parks, Recreation and Entertainment Commission Vacancy



Code Enforcement Monthly Tip

As a friendly reminder, Hughson Municipal Code 8.26.050 (I) states that property maintenance standards and unlawful conditions, which property otherwise maintained is such a blighted condition, or in such a condition of Deterioration or disrepair that the same causes appreciable diminution of the property values of surrounding properties or is materially detrimental to proximal properties and improvements.
