City Mayor Vacancy

On November 23, 2020, Mayor Jeramy Young announced that he had been appointed to the position of the Police Chief of the City of Livermore and would be resigning as Mayor of the City of Hughson effective the end of December 14, 2020, to begin the new position. At the December 14, 2020, Hughson City Council regular meeting, Mayor Young's resignation was accepted by the City Council who also presented him with a plaque thanking him for his many years of service to the City of Hughson.

The City Council then directed staff to place on the January 11, 2021, regular meeting agenda the appointment of a member of the City Council to fill the vacancy of Mayor resulting from the Mayor Young's resignation.
