During the State of the City Address delivered by Mayor George Carr on February 22, 2021, City Manager Merry Mayhew shared with the Hughson City Council and attendees that Rachel Wyse had been selected as the City of Hughson Community Development Director.

Ms. Wyse worked with the Stanislaus County Planning Department since 2006 and has strong planning and building experience providing oversight to a team of planners. Prior to her planning career, Ms. Wyse worked as a counselor for Sierra Vista Children's Center.

Ms. Wyse holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Environmental Studies from California State University, Stanislaus. Ms. Wyse has been married to her husband, Zachary for 20 years and they have two daughters ages 17 and 14.

Ms. Wyse begins with the City of Hughson on March 1, 2021 and will be introduced to the City Council and community during the March 8, 2021 regular meeting. She will lead and oversee key functional areas of the City including planning, building, utilities, public works and parks and recreation. She will work closely with the Mayor, City Council, City Manager, City Attorney and contracted city engineers as needed on a variety of City projects and initiatives.
